Pope Francis to Receive Canadian DelegationArchbishop Richard Smith of the Archdiocese of Edmonton

Canadian Delegation December 17-20

Pope Francis will hear directly from Indigenous peoples on the historical and ongoing legacy of residential schools, as well as their hopes and desires for his visit to Canada. The Catholic Bishops of Canada have invited a group of First Nations, Inuit, and Métis Elders, knowledge keepers, residential school survivors, and youth to meet with Pope Francis at the Vatican from December 17–20, 2021, accompanied by a small group of Canadian Bishops including Archbishop Smith and Bishop McGrattan from Alberta.

As part of the delegation, the Holy Father will participate in three private meetings with First Nations, Inuit, and Métis delegates respectively to hear their personal stories about the lasting legacy of residential schools. Delegates will also have the opportunity to speak with the Holy Father about their hopes and expectations for his eventual pilgrimage to Canada.

Catholic Education Around the Province Conseil scolaire FrancoSud

At Église Sainte Famille, southern Alberta's only Francophone Catholic Church south of Edmonton, the November Catholic Education Mass is prepared annually by Conseil scolaire FrancoSud and its two Calgary Francophone Catholic Schools, École Notre-Dame-de-la-Paix and École Sainte Marguerite Bourgeoys. This year, as a follow-up to the October Municipal elections, FrancoSud's three newly acclaimed Catholic trustees, Mme Hélène Emmell, Mme Geneviève Poulin and Mme Chantal Desjardins, were invited to be part of this mass to receive a benediction from the parish priest, Monseigneur Noël. It was a very touching moment as it brought back memories on the how and the why Sainte Famille was established as a church and parish in the early 1900s.

The first Francophone Catholic settlers had congregated at Notre-Dame-de-la-Paix parish, a parish founded by Father Lacombe, OMI, and located in the Mission District of Calgary which was then known as Rouleville. With the arrival of English and Irish immigrants, the parish was then changed to St Mary's and the St Mary's Cathedral was built on this site. Initially, the French Catholic community was reallocated to Ste Anne's parish in south east Calgary. Wanting to return to the Mission area, the Francophone Catholic community fundraised to buy an unfinished Protestant church on 17th Ave & 5th St SW, Calgary and and then built Sainte Famille church on that site. The church was housed in the basement from 1928 to 1963 and then moved into the newly built white building now known as Église Sainte Famille.

Daniel Therrien, Superintendent, FrancoSud, closed his message to the assembly by stating "that it is now our turn to rebuild, restore, renew together the precious heritage of Francophone Catholic education in Calgary and area. The GrACE mandate was truly made visible as parishioners in attendance were reminded that this beautiful church in which we now meet, is truly the result of a very determined group of French Catholic pioneers who recognized the importance of maintaining one's Catholic Faith in a Francophone environment.

Hi Everyone!

I would like to take this opportunity to express my excitement and gratitude as a new member of the GrACE team for Christ The Redeemer Catholic Schools. I have the honour of being the Chairperson for our local Christ The Redeemer GrACE Committee this year and look forward to working closely with a team that is dedicated to our GrACE mission. I had an interesting start to my own experience with Catholic Education, as it was coming to an official end, sadly and ironically, as I was starting Kindergarten in New Brunswick in 1970. My real exposure to the many gifts and richness of Catholic education came later in life when I joined Christ The Redeemer Catholic Schools in 1991. Since then I have seen many lives transformed, including my own, by the experience and blessing of having faith-based education in our schools. As a cautionary tale, Catholic Education ended with a whimper in my province and once lost, was never to return. The missing key back in 1970 was the lack of "voice" and advocacy. GrACE needs to be a stalwart and vigilant beacon against any hint of diluting Faith in our schools. As a former administrator in both brick and mortar and online schools, I have seen firsthand the measure of importance that Catholicity has had on the journeys of many, including some conversions of families and students during their tenure at our schools.

Our CTR GrACE Committee is launching several activities this year in reference to our short-term goals of having more youth experiences inside and outside of our schools, focus on service, and promoting GrACE more actively in all schools and Parishes. Some of these activities will include Monthly Youth Masses, more youth involvement in Catholic Education Sunday, feature an online event with a formative guest speaker, sharing the "Five Marks" with parents, and a parent/teacher Panel Discussion event later this year.

In addition, communication of GrACE initiatives will be important and we will embark on the creation of school liaisons for GrACE at each school, regular GrACE reports at staff meetings, having School Council parents give regular updates, and continuing to highlight GrACE events, activities and initiatives through our social media portal.

Above all, we see our CTR GrACE Committee as a catalyst for action for those we serve...students, families, and staff and to be a faithful guide for them in all aspects of their Catholic lives.


